### Acts of the Apostles: Acts 2:1-13

Something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire; these separated and came to rest on the head of each one of them.

Now there were devout people living in Jerusalem from every nation under heaven, and at this sound they all assembled. But they were bewildered to hear their native languages being spoken.
