Adapted from Isaiah 11:5-9




There will be no harm, no destruction anywhere in my holy mountain; for as water fills the sea, so the land will be filled with the knowledge of YHWH."





# The Book of Jeremiah (Jeremiah 18:1-7)




The word that came to Jeremiah from YHWH: "Get up and make your way down to the potter's house. I will give you my message there."

"May the peace of the Risen Christ be with you!" And also with you.




