




Unison Prayer

and grieves a little at each of our leavings.

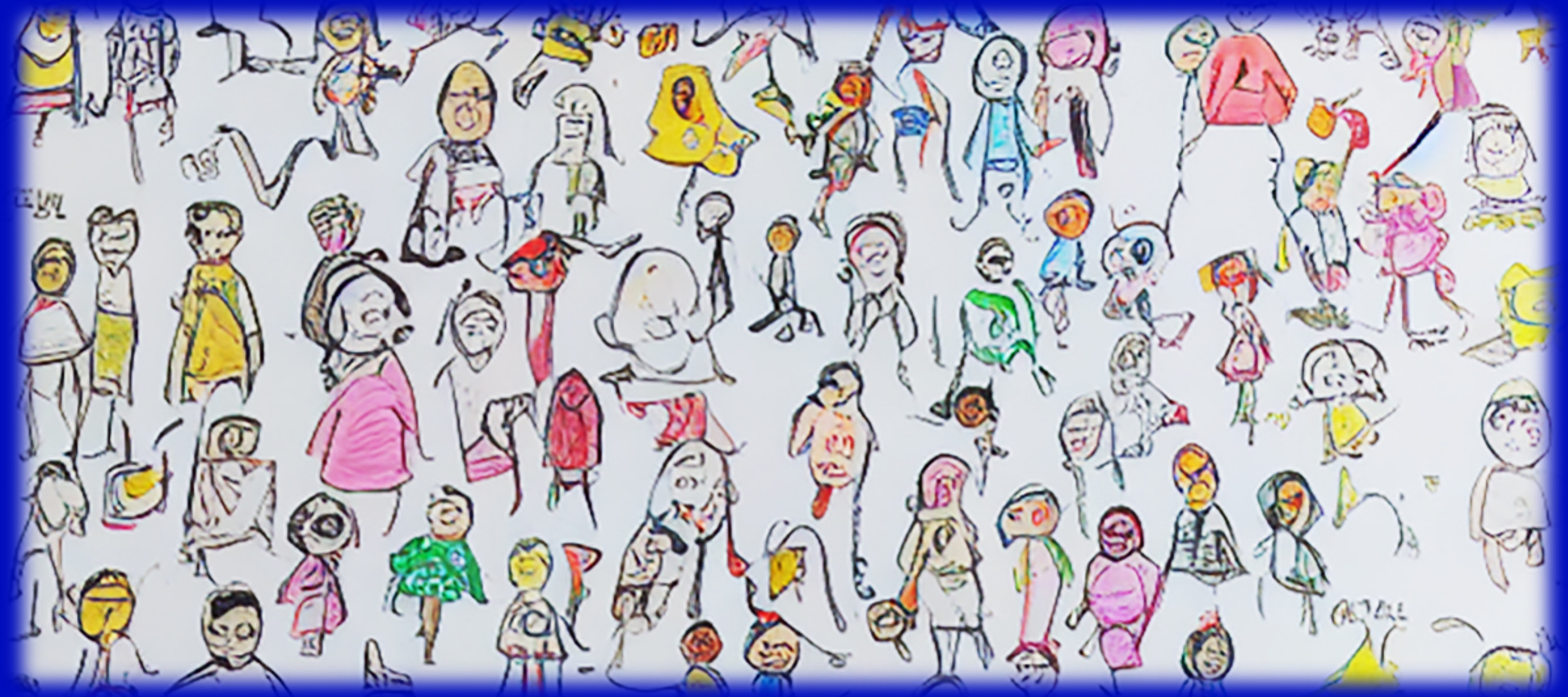


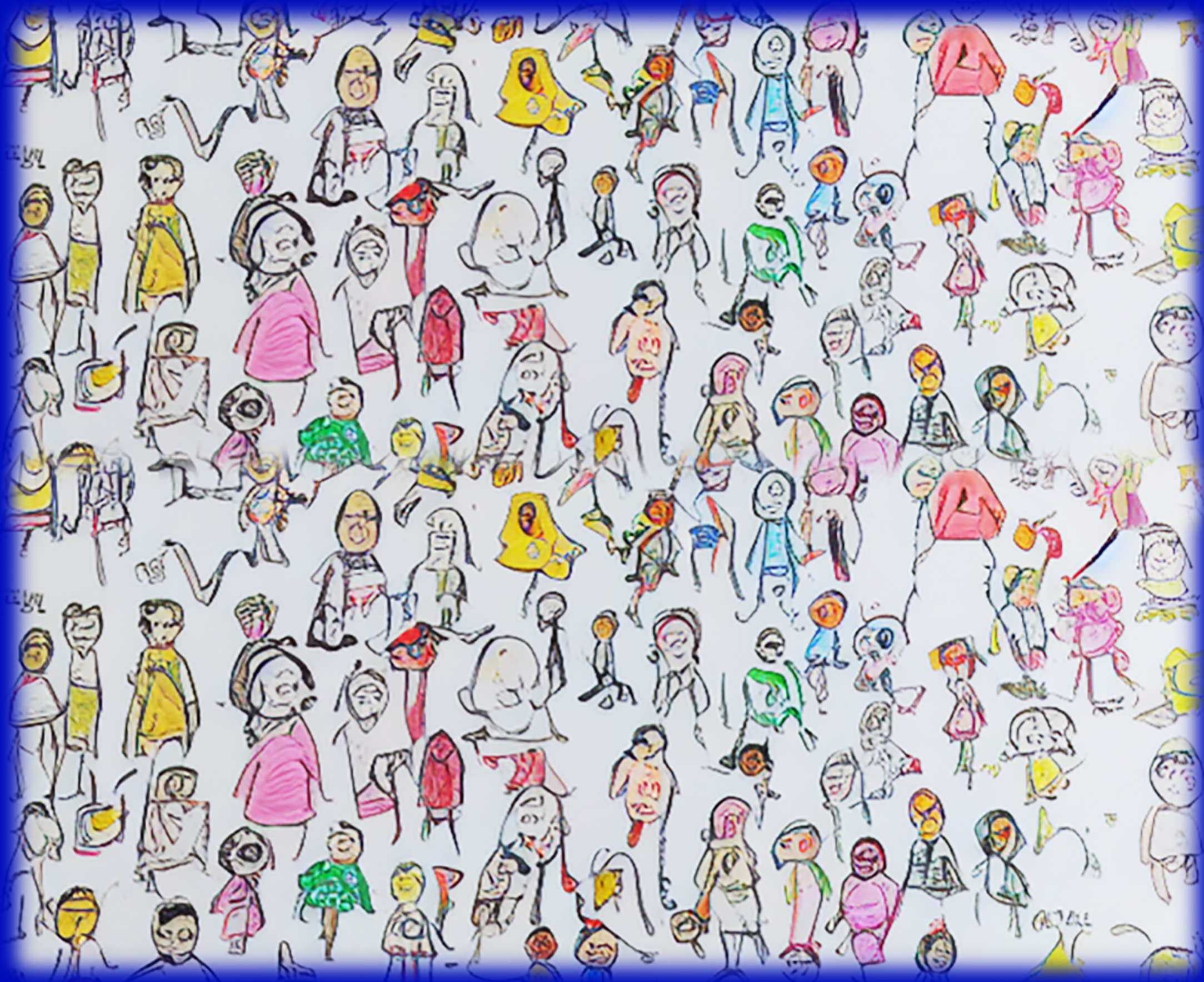
