

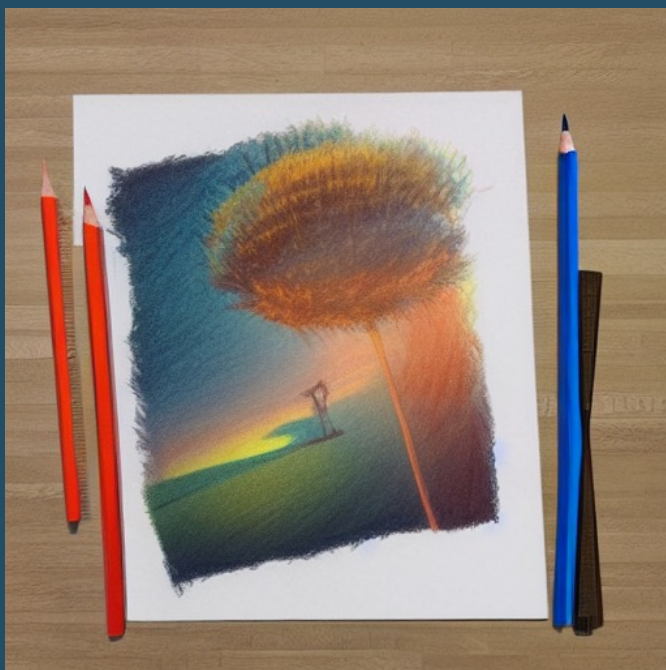

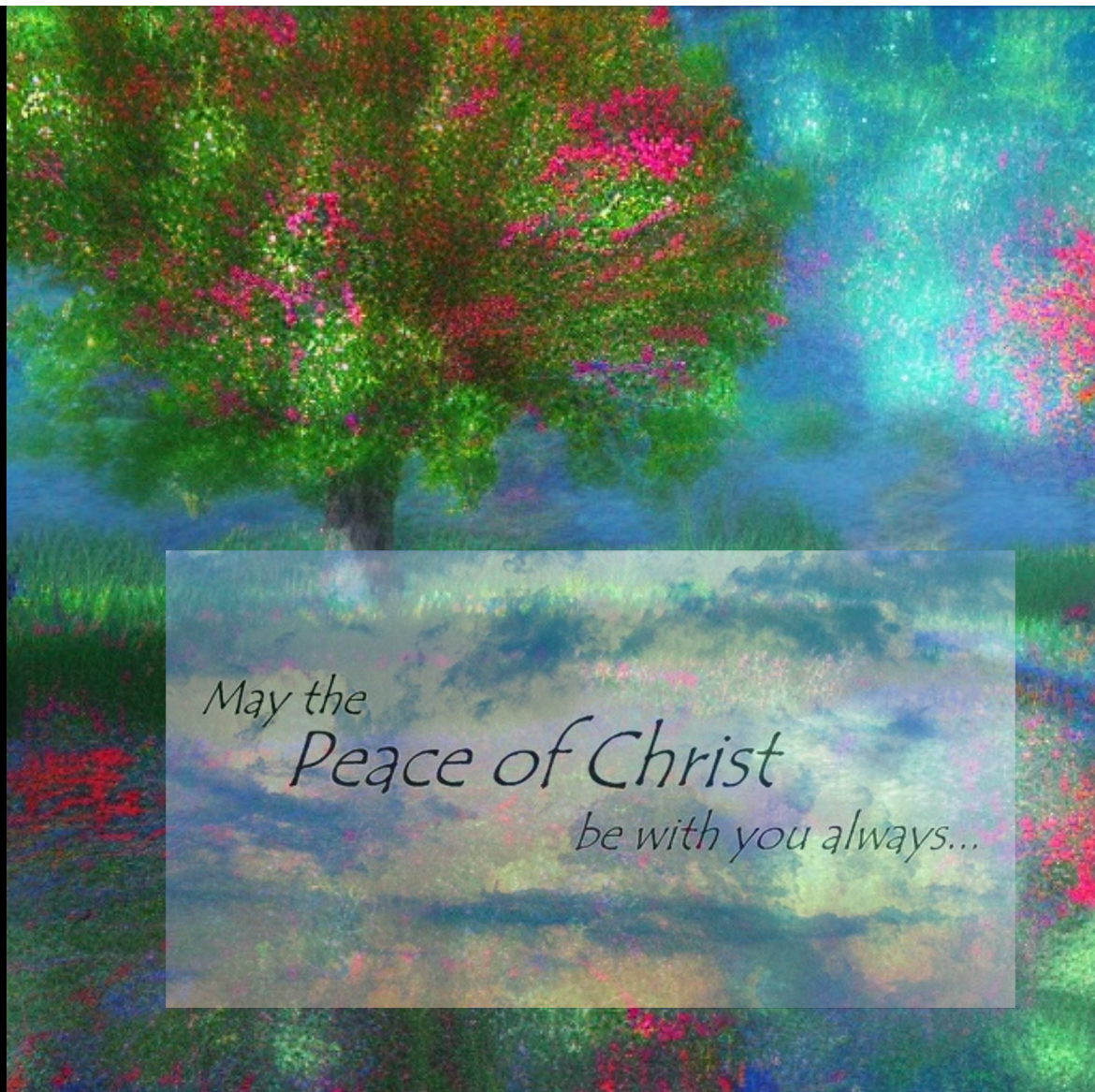

## Church Covenant



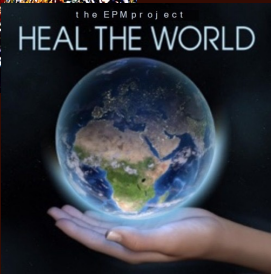
In response to God's love,
