### Transgender Day of Remembrance



Join us Sunday at the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship at Stony Point for the Long Island Transgender Day of Remembrance.

Transgender Day of Remembrance (TDOR) is an annual observance on November 20th that honors the memory of the transgender people whose lives were lost in acts of anti-transgender violence.

The origins of Transgender Day of Remembrance can be traced to the killing of Rita Hester. On November 28, 1998. Hester, a Black transgender woman from Boston, Massachusetts, was stabbed and killed in her own apartment. Gwendolyn Ann Smith, a transgender woman from San Francisco, began the "Remembering Our Dead" website memorial in order to commemorate the lives of transgender people who have been killed. Twenty-four years later we remember and stand in solidarity with the Trans Community.
