James Johnson started his law enforcement career in 2005 with the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Air Marshal Service. Prior to that time, he served in the United States Army as an intelligence professional, deploying to the Salah ad Din Province of Iraq with 1-111<sup>th</sup> Infantry on 2008-2009.

In 2010 James started his career with the Suffolk County Police Department, first working in patrol and various plain clothes units in the First Precinct before transferring to the newly established Human Trafficking Investigations Unit in 2017.

He is currently assigned to the Long Island FBI task force for human trafficking and child exploitation. He holds an Associate of Science Degree in Intelligence Operations from Cochise College, a Bachelor of Science degree in Crime, Law and Justice from the Pennsylvania State University, and a Master of Arts degree in Journalism/Communication from the University of Alabama.
