Gospel Reading Matthew 23:1-12

<sup>23:1</sup> Jesus told the crowds and the disciples, <sup>2</sup> "The religious scholars and the Pharisees have succeeded Moses as teachers; <sup>3</sup> therefore, perform every observance they tell you to. But don't follow their example; even they don't do what they say. <sup>4</sup> They tie up heavy loads and lay them on others' shoulders, while they themselves will not lift a finger to help alleviate the burden.

<sup>5</sup> "All their works are performed to be seen. They widen their phylacteries and wear huge tassels. <sup>6</sup> They are fond of places of honor at banquets and the front seats in synagogues. <sup>7</sup> They love respectful greetings in public and being called 'Rabbi.'

<sup>8</sup> "But as for you, avoid the title 'Rabbi.' For you have only one Teacher, and you are all siblings and kin. <sup>9</sup> And remember you have only one Parent—our loving God in heaven. <sup>10</sup> Avoid being called leaders. You have only one leader—the Messiah. <sup>11</sup> "The greatest among you will be the one who serves the rest. <sup>12</sup> Those who exalt themselves will be humbled, but those who humble themselves will be exalted.
